

The University of Milano Bicocca offers **12 fellowships** in **Physics and Astronomy** for its **three years PhD** program in Physics. One fellowship is reserved to applicants with qualifications obtained abroad and is assigned via an independent selection process. Three fellowships are associated with specific projects (see below) while the others students can choose their project among: theoretical physics, subnuclear physics, physical technologies, astrophysics, plasma physics and biophysics.

Each fellowship offers 16238 €/yr gross salary and a 3200€ personal budget for attending international schools. Additional internal contracts are available for part-time teaching assistantship. Benefits are available for lodging at the University guesthouses.

The application call is now open
Application deadline July 3rd, 2017

The selections will take place on July 24, 25, 26 and 27, 2017.

To be admitted to the PhD program, selected candidates should obtain their master degree before 31 October 2017.

The application should include the candidate *CV, a research project and two letters of recommendation*. The selection process includes an *interview* (also possible via video conference).
